### LEAGUE CLASSIFICATION

Any youth who is or will be five years old before September 1 of the current year and who will not be seven until after September 1 of the current year shall be eligible to compete in **5 & 6 YEAR OLD LEAGUE**.

Any youth who is or will be seven years old before September 1 of the current year and who will not be nine until after September 1 of the current year shall be eligible to compete in the **7 & 8 YEAR OLD LEAGUE**.

Any youth who is or will be nine before September 1 of the current year and will not be eleven until after September 1 of the current year shall be eligible to compete in the **9 & 10 YEAR OLD LEAGUE**.

Any youth who is or will be eleven years old before September 1 of the current year and who will not be thirteen until after September 1 of the current year shall be eligible to compete in the **11 & 12 YEAR OLD LEAGUE**.

IN ORDER TO OFFSET TOURNAMENT EXPENSES, EACH CHILD WILL BE CHARGED A FEE AND ADDITIONAL FEE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL STAR COMPETITION.

**PARENTAL FORM**

The BIDDY BASKETBALL PROGRAM is for young people to have a wholesome recreational outlet through playing basketball. The intent of the program is to teach sportsmanship, teamwork, cooperation, discipline, and fair play. With these ideals in mind, it is incumbent on the parents to assist with these goals. While parents are an integral part of the program, there have been situations in which parents have not displayed the ideals the program is trying to teach. To establish guidelines for parents, the following is a list of rules to which parents must adhere:

1. Parents must not display unsportsmanlike or inappropriate behavior at any time.
2. The BIDDY BASKETBALL COMMITTEE will administer all league functions. The parents must address the board to deal with any problems they may have with the league. No subversive bickering that adversely affects the league will be tolerated.
3. Derogatory or abusive statements or actions to league supervisors, referees, or coaches will NOT be tolerated.
4. Fan enthusiasm at games is encouraged. However, if fan enthusiasm evolves to a point where the opposing team is embarrassed or ridiculed, then removal from the gym will be mandated.
5. If any of these rules are violated, penalties will be enacted by the Board to coincide with the violation. Penalties will be at the discretion of the Board and may include any action legally possible on parents as well as removal of players from Recreation Department activities.

**PLAYERS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE PROGRAM BECAUSE OF RULE VIOLATIONS OF THEIR PARENTS.**

It is hoped that these rules need not be enforced; however, the COMMITTEE feels that it is imperative that stringent rules be followed in order to insure our Youth will be given the best positive lessons from the Biddy Basketball Program. If anyone feels that they cannot comply with the above rules, parents and youths should pursue other forms of recreation.
