PARENTAL AUTHORIZATION

I, parent or guardian of the above-named candidate for participation in the baseball program, hereby give approval in any and all activities during the current season. I assume all risks and hazards incidental to and from the activities and do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify, and agree to hold harmless the local league organization, the organizers, sponsors, schools, supervisors, participants, and persons transporting the player to and from activities for any claim arising out of an injury to the participant.

I also grant permission to managing personnel or other Recreation Department representatives to obtain and authorize medical care should the participant become ill or injured while participating in activities away from home, or at times when neither parent is available to grant authorization for emergency treatment.

I agree to return, upon request, the uniform and other equipment issued to players in as good condition as when it is received, except for normal wear and tear.

Each Participant in all leagues will pay a fee of \$45.00, the second participant in the family will pay of fee of \$35.00, and the third participant in the family will pay a fee of \$20.00. No family will be charged more than \$100 for three or more participants in a baseball league or a combination of baseball leagues. If issued, the player must return his/her uniform by a specified time as stated by the coach or the child will not be able to participate in any M.C.R.D. team sport until the uniform is returned. The expense of the replacement uniform will be billed to the parents.

Anyone who cannot afford the player fee will not be refused participation. Parents must give notice to the Recreation Department if any financial problem exists. There will be a meeting with the Youth Baseball Board to decide payment arrangements.

I WILL FURNISH A BIRTH CERTIFICATE. I WILL BE RESPONSIBLE TO ASSURE THAT MY CHILD IS PHYSICALLY ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM PRIOR TO ENROLLING.

LEAGUE CLASSIFICATIONS

T-BALL LEAGUE
(5 – 6 years)

Any youth who is or will be five years old before May 1st of the current year shall be eligible to compete in the T-Ball League.

MINOR LEAGUE
(7 – 8 years)

Any youth who is or will be seven years old before May 1st of the current year shall be eligible to compete in the Minor League.

CITY LEAGUE
(9 – 10 years)

Any youth who is or will be nine years old before May 1st of the current year shall be eligible to compete in the City League.

DIXIE LEAGUE
(11 – 12 years)

Any youth who is or will be eleven years old before May 1st of the current year shall be eligible to compete in the Dixie League.

PARENTAL FORM

The Minor, City, and Dixie Leagues are for young people to have a wholesome recreational outlet through playing baseball. The intent of the program is to teach sportsmanship, teamwork, cooperation, discipline, and fair play. With these ideals in mind, it is incumbent on the parents to assist with these goals. While parents are an integral part of the program, there have been situations in which parents have not displayed the ideals of the program is trying to teach. To establish guidelines for parents, the following is a list of rules to which the parents must adhere:

1. Parents must not display any unsportsmanlike or inappropriate behavior at any time.
2. The Youth Baseball Committee will administer all league functions. The parents must address the Board to deal with any problems that they may have with the league. No subversive bickering that adversely affects the league will be tolerated.
3. Derogatory or abusive statements or actions to league supervisors, umpires, or coaches will **NOT** be tolerated.
4. Fan enthusiasm at games is encouraged, however, if fan enthusiasm evolves to a point where the opposing teams are embarrassed or ridiculed, at that time removal from the park will be mandated.
5. If any of these rules are violated, the Committee to commensurate with the violation will enact penalties. Penalties will be at the Discretion of the Committee and may include any action legally possible on parents as well as removal of players from the Recreation Department activities.

PLAYERS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE PROGRAMS BECAUSE OF RULE VIOLATIONS OF THEIR PARENTS

It is hoped that these rules need not be enforced; however, the Committee feels that it is imperative that stringent rules be followed in order to ensure our children will be given the best positive lessons from the baseball program. If anyone feels that they cannot comply with the above rules, parents and youths should pursue other forms of recreation.

Fundraising is a very important part of the program in that it provides financing for league play, field maintenance, capital projects and all-stars. Throughout the year, you and your child will be asked to assist with these fundraising efforts. Your cooperation would be greatly appreciated.
